An Act providing for access to baby-changing stations.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 143 of the Massachusetts General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 inserting after section 90 the following section:-

3           Section 90A. All new or substantially renovated buildings which are reasonably expected  
4 to be open to the public shall be charged with providing safe and equally accessible changing  
5 tables in bathrooms regardless of gender.
