An Act establishing Massachusetts Freedom Day.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section
2 12V in its entirety and inserting in place thereof the following:-

3 Section 12V. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart the Tuesday
4 next after the first Monday in the month of November as Massachusetts Freedom Day and
5 recommending that it be observed by the people, with appropriate exercises in the schools and
6 otherwise, to celebrate free and fair elections, which are the cornerstone of a vibrant, successful
7 democracy, by protecting the freedom to vote for all residents of the commonwealth.
