*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 2 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following  
2 section:-

3           Section 64. The “Giant Puffball” fungus, *calvatia gigantea*, shall be the official  
4 mushroom of the Commonwealth.
