An Act relative to municipal procurement.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 39M of chapter 30 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the words “on the COMMBUYS system  
3 administered by the operational services division, (3)”.

4           SECTION 2. Section 44A of chapter 149 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016  
5 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the words “on the COMMBUYS system  
6 administered by the operational services division, (3)”.
