An Act establishing 413 day.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section  
2 15BBBBBB the following section:-

3 Section 15CCCCC. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting aside  
4 April thirteenth as 413 Day, to promote tourism, economic development, and the unique culture  
5 of western Massachusetts and recommending that said day be observed in an appropriate manner  
6 by the people.
