An Act reducing library non-ionizing radiation exposures from wireless and electricity.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 78 of the General Laws is hereby amended, in Section 19G, as  
2 appearing in the 2016 Official Edition, by inserting after the first paragraph the following  
3 paragraph:-

4           The board shall use funding to encourage public libraries to reduce non-ionizing radiation  
5 exposure, including from use of wireless communications and electronic technology, through  
6 hard-wiring connections, segregating areas of exposure, product purchase, and other means to  
7 reduce non-ionizing emissions from technologies.
