An Act relative to investigators at the Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 72 of Chapter 10 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word ‘commission,’ in line 13, the  
3 following:-

4           " Said investigators shall have all the power of a police officer in a city or town, with  
5 reference to enforcement of the laws, excluding chapter ninety, of the commonwealth."

6           SECTION 2. Section 56 of Chapter 138 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby  
7 amended by inserting after the word ‘chapter,’ in line 11, the following:-

8           " Said investigators shall have all the power of a police officer in a city or town, with  
9 reference to enforcement of the laws, excluding chapter ninety, of the commonwealth."
