An Act relative to retail liquor sales to caterers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 12C of chapter 138 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after “section 18” in the fifth sentence, as  
3   amended by chapter 190 of the of the acts of 2012, the following words:- or a retailer licensed  
4   pursuant to section 15.

5           SECTION 2. Section 12C of Chapter 138 of the General Laws, as so appearing, shall  
6   cease to be effective on January 1, 2018.
