An Act relative to municipal net metering facilities.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 138 of Chapter 164 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 37, after the word “less”, the following
3 words:- “provided, however, that a Class I net metering facility of a municipality or other
4 governmental entity may have a generating capacity of less than or equal to 60 kilowatts per
5 unit”.

6 SECTION 2. Said section is hereby further amended by striking out in line 120 the words
7 “Class II or III” and replacing them with the words “Class I, II or III”.
