An Act relative to solar net metering fairness.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 9 (j) of Chapter 75 of the Acts of 2016 is hereby amended by striking the first  
2 sentence of the third paragraph and inserting at the beginning of the paragraph:-

3           The department shall exempt any monthly minimum reliability contribution for low-  
4 income ratepayers and community solar ratepayers. The department may exempt or modify any  
5 monthly minimum reliability contribution for municipal ratepayers.
