**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

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**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court  
(2019-2020)**  
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An Act relative to requiring notification of hazardous utility work to local and regional emergency departments.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, utility
- 2 companies would be require the notification of both local and regional police, fire, emergency
- 3 and all other related public works departments of any hazardous public work projects conducted
- 4 by that utility company or an independent contractor within their jurisdiction.
