**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act relative to fair radius restrictions of transfer stations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 150A of Chapter 111 shall be amended by inserting at the end
2 thereof the following:-

3 No facility governed by section 150A or 150A1/2 of chapter 111 shall be constructed
4 within 6 miles of an existing facility governed by those sections.
