**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act relative to Hot Box Detectors.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 176 of said chapter 160 of the General Laws as so appears is
2 hereby amended by inserting after the word "cars" the following words:- or tracks and by
3 inserting after the word "commonwealth" the following new language:- Hot Box detectors should
4 be installed every 20 miles on any line in which passenger trains operate. Such should be
5 included in any new construction project and within one year of the passage of said law on all
6 existing lines.
