**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court  
(2019-2020)**

An Act relative to school attendance incentives.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the MBTA shall  
2 issue free bus, train, and commuter rail passes for the months of June, July, and August to any  
3 Public School student, grade 8-12, who meets the following qualifications in the school year  
4 immediately preceding that June:-

- 5           a) Qualifies for free or reduced price lunch
- 6           b) Has a demonstrable record of attending at least 90% of school days in that school year
- 7           c) Receives a free or subsidized MBTA pass during the school year

8           SECTION 2. This legislation shall be subject the approval of the local school committee.
