An Act relative to a clean fuel standard.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Within one year of the effective date of this act, the Department of
- 2 Transportation shall promulgate regulations to develop and implement a clean fuel standard.
- 3 Said clean fuel standard shall aim to reduce the carbon intensity of transportation fuels, while
- 4 accounting for the full lifecycle greenhouse gas emissions of all fuels.
