**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act designating a certain bridge in the town of Dedham as the Honorable Kelly A. Timilty
Memorial Bridge.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Bridge D-05-011 on Sawmill Lane, spanning Mother Brook in the Town of
2 Dedham, shall be designated and known as the “Honorable Kelly A. Timilty Memorial Bridge”
3 in recognition of Kelly A. Timilty. Kelly was a beloved public servant who served nine
4 consecutive terms before five governors on the Governor's Council. Kelly was the youngest child
5 of Joseph F. Timilty, former state senator, and the sister of the Honorable James E. Timilty. She
6 passed away before her time on January 31, 2012. The Massachusetts Department of
7 Transportation shall erect and maintain a suitable marker bearing the designation in compliance
8 with the standards of the department.
