Honan, Kate Hogan and other members of the General Court for legislation to establish a committee to study an appropriate location for a memorial to LGBT service members and veterans. In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court

An Act establishing a committee to study an appropriate location for a memorial to LGBT service members and veterans.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. There shall be a special commission established to investigate and study the
2 history of LGBT service members and veterans in Massachusetts, and to determine an
3 appropriate location for a memorial to their service. The commission shall report its findings,
4 including any proposed legislation, to the house and senate committees on ways and means, the
5 joint committee on Veterans and Federal Affairs and the Department of Capital Asset
6 Management no later than June 1, 2021.

7 SECTION 2. The commission shall consist of: 2 members of the senate, 1 of whom shall
8 serve as co-chair appointed by the Senate President, and 1 of whom shall be a member of the
9 minority party appointed by the senate minority leader; 2 members of the house of
10 representatives appointed by the Speaker, 1 of whom shall serve as co-chair, and 1 of whom shall
11 be a member of the minority party appointed by the house minority leader; the house and senate

12 chairs of the joint committee on Veteran and Federal Affairs or their designees; the Secretary of
13 the Department on Veteran Services or a designee ; the commissioner of Veterans Services of the
14 city of Boston or a designee; and 1 member appointed by the Governor, selected from a list of 3
15 persons nominated by OutVets.
