An Act relative to reimbursement to armed service members.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 59 of chapter 33 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking  
2 subsection (e) and inserting in place thereof the following:-

3           (e) An employee of a county, city or town which shall be entitled to the benefits and  
4 protections of this section or the benefits of the accepted earlier law.
