An Act authorizing the appointment of retired police officers as special police officers in the town of Milton.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Subject to the approval of the town administrator of the town of Milton, the  
2 chief of police of the town of Milton may appoint retired Milton police officers as special police  
3 officers for the purpose of performing police details or any police duties arising from police  
4 details or during the course of police detail work, whether or not related to the detail work. The  
5 retired police officers shall have been regular Milton police officers and retired based upon  
6 superannuation. A retired police officer shall not be appointed under this act as a special police  
7 officer if the officer has been retired for more than 5 years. A special police officer appointed  
8 under this act shall not be subject to the same maximum age restrictions applied to regular  
9 Milton police officers under chapter 32 of the General Laws; provided, however, that a special  
10 police officer shall not be able to serve if the special police officer has reached the age of 70.  
11 Prior to performing police details, a special police officer appointed under this act shall pass a  
12 medical examination by a physician or other certified professional chosen or agreed to by the  
13 department to determine that the retired police officer is capable of performing the essential  
14 duties of a special police officer, the cost of which shall be borne by the special police officer.

15 SECTION 2. A special police officer appointed under this act shall not be subject to  
16 chapter 31, section 99A of chapter 41 or chapter 150E of the General Laws.

17 SECTION 3. A special police officer appointed under this act shall, when performing the  
18 duties under section 1, have the same power to make arrests and perform other police functions  
19 as regular police officers of the town of Milton.

20 SECTION 4. A special police officer appointed under this act shall be appointed for an  
21 indefinite term, subject to suspension or removal by the chief of police with approval of the town  
22 administrator at any time. A special police officer shall be provided 14 calendar days written  
23 notice prior to a permanent removal.

24 SECTION 5. A special police officer appointed under this act shall be subject to the  
25 rules, regulations, policies, procedures and requirements of the chief of police including, but not  
26 limited to: (i) restrictions on the type of detail assignments; (ii) requirements regarding medical  
27 examinations to determine continuing capability to perform the duties of a special police officer;  
28 (iii) requirements for training; (iv) requirements for firearms licensing and qualifications; (v)  
29 requirements for maintaining a medical or liability insurance policy; and (vi) requirements  
30 regarding uniforms and equipment. A special police officer shall not be subject to section 96B of  
31 chapter 41 of the General Laws. The cost of all training, uniforms and equipment shall be borne  
32 by the special police officer.

33 SECTION 6. Special police officers appointed under this act shall be sworn before the  
34 town clerk of the town of Milton who shall keep a record of all such appointments.

35 SECTION 7. Sections 85H and 85H1/2 of chapter 32 and sections 100 and 111F of  
36 chapter 41 of the General Laws shall not apply to a special police officer appointed under this  
37 act.

38 SECTION 8. Appointment as a special police officer under this act shall not entitle the  
39 appointee to assignment to any detail.

40 SECTION 9. A retired Milton police officer serving as a special police officer under this  
41 act shall be subject to the limitations on hours worked and on payments to retired town  
42 employees under paragraph (b) of section 91 of chapter 32 of the General Laws.

43 SECTION 10. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
