An Act relative to the disclosure of smoking within a multi-residence building by lessor.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 186 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition, is hereby
- 2 amended by inserting the following new section after section 21:-
- 3 Section 21A. Disclosure of smoking within a multi-residence building by lessor;
- 4 violations
- 5 Section 21A. The lessor of any residential property shall disclose prominently in the lease
- 6 if the building in which the residence is located permits smoking of any kind in any area or
- 7 residence. If the lessor violates this section, the lessee shall be entitled to break the lease and the
- 8 lessor shall be required to pay the lessee the value of three months' rent under the terms of the
- 9 lease.
