Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 57A(b) of chapter 6C as appearing in the 2018 official edition is
- 2 hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following new clause (e):- "(e) In determining
- 3 any surcharge points that may result in a premium increase, and changes in safe driver credits the
- 4 board shall examine the driver's driving history, and severity of accident".
- 5 SECTION 2. This act shall be effective as of October 1, 2018.
