**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Wilfredo Bosque-Rosa, an employee of the Department of Correction.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary, the
2 department of children and families shall establish a sick leave bank for Wilfredo Bosque-Rosa,
3 an employee of the department. Any employee of the department may voluntarily contribute 1 of
4 more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Wilfredo Bosque-Rosa.
5 Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that
6 necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the department. Whenever
7 Wilfredo Bosque-Rosa terminates employment with the department or requests to dissolve the
8 sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended
9 illness leave bank.
