An Act relative to removing the position of police chief from civil service.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The position of police chief in the town of Charlton shall not be subject to  
2 chapter 31 of the Massachusetts General Laws.

3           SECTION 2. Section 1 of this act shall not impair the civil service status of any person  
4 holding the position of police chief in the town of Charlton on the effective date of this act.

5           SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
