RESOLVED, THAT THE SENATOR FROM THE SECOND BRISTOL AND PLYMOUTH DISTRICT, MR. MICHAEL D. BRADY, SHALL BE REMOVED AS SENATE CHAIR OF THE JOINT COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC SERVICE.
