Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 2-10 of the charter of the city of Gloucester, which is on file in the office of the
- 2 archivist of the commonwealth, as provided in section 12 of chapter 43B of the General Laws, is
- 3 hereby amended by striking out in section 2-10 (b) the following:- "No un-elected appointee
- 4 shall be appointed to more than one multiple member body, unless said board or commission is
- 5 inter-related" and and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:- "No un-elected
- 6 appointee shall be appointed to more than two multiple member bodies."
