1           *Ordered*, That by the authority of Article IV of Section II of Chapter I of the  
2 Constitution, the Senate declares that, by reason of the resignation of Donald F. Humason, Jr. as  
3 Senator from the Second Hampden and Hampshire district, the office of senator from the Second  
4 Hampden and Hampshire district is vacant. By the authority of Article XXIV of the  
5 Amendments to the Constitution, the Senate directs the president of the Senate to issue a precept  
6 setting forth March 31, 2020, as the day for holding an election to fill the vacancy in the Second  
7 Hampden and Hampshire district, comprising of the cities of Chicopee, ward 7, precincts A and  
8 B, ward 8, precinct A, ward 9, precinct A, Holyoke and Westfield and the towns of Agawam,  
9 Granville, Montgomery, Russell, Southwick and Tolland, in the county of Hampden; and the  
10 towns of Easthampton and Southampton in the county of Hampshire.
