An Act authorizing Nikos Sofronas to take the civil service examination for the position of firefighter in the city of Haverhill notwithstanding the maximum age requirement.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary  
2   regulating the maximum age of applications for appointment as firefighter, Nikos Sofronas of the  
3   City of Haverhill, shall be eligible for appointment to the position of firefighter in the City if she  
4   meets all other requirements, in which case she shall be eligible for certification and appointment  
5   to the fire department of the City of Haverhill. To be effective for the March 21, 2020 firefighter  
6   examination results.

7           Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
