## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

1 by striking out the text in its entirety and inserting in place thereof the following text:-2 Ordered, Whereas, on March 10, 2020, pursuant to executive order No. 591, the governor 3 declared a state of emergency in the commonwealth to respond to the 2019 novel coronavirus, 4 also known as COVID-19, and such a state of emergency continues to exist in the 5 commonwealth; and 6 Whereas, Joint Rule 12A requires that all formal business of the second annual session be 7 concluded not later than the last day of July 2020; and 8 Whereas, it is critical for the senate and house of representatives to continue convening in 9 formal session to respond to, and mitigate the spread of, COVID-19 to protect the health, 10 security, safety, economic well-being and convenience of the people of the commonwealth; now 11 therefore be it 12 Ordered, That, the senate and house of representatives declare that a state of emergency 13 exists within the General Court; and be it further

- Ordered, That, notwithstanding Joint Rule 12A, the formal business of the second annual
- session may continue after the last day of July 2020.
