

Senate, December 29, 2020 -- Text of the Senate amendment (Senator Hinds) to the House Bill authorizing the town of Egremont to seek approval to utilize a portion of French Park to construct a broadband headend (House, No. 4963).

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

1	(a) The town of Egremont, acting through its board of selectmen, as trustees under the
2	tenth paragraph of the will of Mabel R. French Champion, may utilize a portion of French park
3	shown on the town assessors' map 9, parcel 982, approximately 180 feet northerly of the
4	southeast corner of the town's tax map 9, parcel 982, at latitude 42.190154 and longitude -
5	73.439622, for the purposes of constructing a broadband headend, as well as any easements or
6	rights of way necessary to maintain such facilities.
7	(b) As a condition of the authorization granted in section 1 and to ensure no net loss of
8	land under Article 97 of the Amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth, the town of
9	Egremont shall expand the trail network in the southeast section of French park to benefit public
10	passive recreation access.
