An Act relative to affordable assisted living facilities.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary the Department  
2   of Housing and Community Development in consultation with the Executive Office of Health  
3   and Human services shall develop a statewide master plan to increase the availability of  
4   affordable assisted living facilities, said facilities shall be for people at least 300 percent below  
5   the federal poverty line. Said master plan shall be submitted to the clerks of the house and senate,  
6   and the joint committee on housing by December 31, 2019.
