Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 210 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in the first sentence, the words “, or brother,
3 sister, uncle or aunt, of the whole or half blood”.
