An Act to strengthen pharmacy benefit management.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 226 of Chapter 175 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 adding the following after subsection (p) thereof:-
- 3 (g) The commissioner shall promulgate regulations for the licensing of pharmacy benefit
- 4 managers providing services in the Commonwealth, which shall consist of, but not be limited to,
- 5 provisions which:
- 6 1. Require a minimum standard of qualification or accreditation
- 7 2. Minimize actual or potential conflicts of interest
- 8 3. Provide for regular audits of the operations and activities of entities licensed hereunder

- 9 4. Provide a mechanism for the submission of, hearing, and disposition of claims of
- 10 unfair practices by such licenses
