An Act relative to local public housing authorities.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 5 of Chapter 44B of the General Laws is hereby amended in clause
2 (b) (2) by adding after the words “not be used for maintenance” the following words “provided
3 however local public housing authorities established pursuant to Chapter 121B may use such
4 funds only for extraordinary maintenance, equipment replacement betterments and additions”.
