An Act relative to mandated reporters of disabled persons abuse.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 19C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the words “police officer”, in the definition  
3   of “Mandated reporter”, the following words:- “, firefighter, emergency medical technician,”.
