Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 21 of chapter 120 is hereby amended by adding the following
- 2 sentence to the end thereof:-
- A juvenile court adjudication shall not be used as a predicate offense that triggers a
- 4 mandatory minimum sentence.
- 5 SECTION 2. Section 100B of chapter 276 is hereby amended by adding the following
- 6 sentence to the end thereof:-
- Notwithstanding any other provision to the contrary, a juvenile court adjudication shall
- 8 not be used as a predicate offense that triggers a mandatory minimum sentence.
