An Act relative to the composition of the Group Insurance Commission.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 32A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out in line 5 the words “and 13 members” and  
3 inserting in place thereof, the following words:- the president of the Retired State, County and  
4 Municipal Employees Association of Massachusetts or a designee, and 12 members.
