An Act relative to the Massachusetts Commission Against Discrimination.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 56 of chapter 6 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “women”, in line 47, the
3 following words:- ; individuals who identify as gay, lesbian, bisexual, questioning or queer;
4 individuals who identify as transgender.
