**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act relative to the inventory tax.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 5 of chapter 59 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition, is
2 hereby amended by inserting after clause Nineteenth the following clause:-

3 Nineteenth A. Merchandise situated in Massachusetts, including inventory held for sale;
4 finished goods; products, goods, wares or stock in trade; work in progress; materials or supplies;
5 and archived or stored goods.
