An Act relative to families impacted by substance misuse.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the department of children  
2   and families, in consultation with the department of public health, shall collect, record and  
3   analyze non-identifying statistical data on children and families involved with the department in  
4   connection with substance use or misuse. The department of children and families shall annually  
5   submit a report, which shall include aggregate data collected for the preceding calendar year and  
6   the department's analysis, with the clerks of the house of representatives and the senate and the  
7   department of public health not later than December 31.
