Senate, March 7, 2019 -- Order (Senator DiDomenico) relative to a technical amendment to the Senate Rules

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

- 1 Ordered, That the Rules of the Senate be amended by adding the following rule:-
- 2 11E. Members of the Senate may be compensated for service in no more than 2 positions,
- 3 whether as a member of leadership or as a chair, vice-chair or ranking member of a committee.;
- 4 and
- 5 in Rule 12, by striking out, the figure "8", the second time it appears, and inserting in place
- 6 thereof the following figure:- "7"; and
- 7 in Rule 13 by striking the words "not more than 3"; and
- 8 further in said Rule 13 by striking the words "not more than 4"; and
- 9 by striking rule 62B and inserting in place thereof the following rule:-
- 10 62B. (a) The Chief Financial Officer of the Senate shall complete the procurement of all goods
- and services for the Senate. Procurements for goods or services shall be made from the statewide

- 12 procurement contract established by the operational services division, to the extent practicable,
- as determined by the Chief Financial Officer. If the Chief Financial Officer determines that a
- procurement cannot be made using the statewide procurement contract established by the
- operational services division, the Chief Financial Officer may procure the required goods or
- services under subsections (b), (c) or (d).
- 17 (b) Procurement of a supply or service from a vendor not on the statewide procurement contract
- valued at less than \$10,000 shall be made at the discretion of the Chief Financial Officer.
- 19 (c) If the Chief Financial Officer seeks to procure a supply or service from a vendor not on the
- statewide procurement contract valued at \$10,000 or more, but less than \$100,000, the Chief
- 21 Financial Officer shall seek quotations from not fewer than 3 persons providing such supply or
- service. The Chief Financial Officer shall record the names and addresses of all persons from
- 23 whom quotations were received, the names of the persons submitting quotations and the date and
- amount of each quotation. The Chief Financial Officer shall award the contract to the responsible
- 25 person whose quotation offers the needed quality of supply or service and which represents the
- best value for the Senate.
- 27 (d) If the Chief Financial Officer seeks to procure a supply or service from a vendor not on the
- statewide procurement contract valued at \$100,000 or more, the Chief Financial Officer shall
- seek proposals through a competitive bid process, which shall be established by the Chief
- 30 Financial Officer
- 31 (e) The Chief Financial Officer shall maintain a file on each procurement not executed using the
- 32 statewide procurement contract established by the operational services division and in excess of
- \$10,000 and shall include in such file all documents constituting the agreement for goods and

- services and all documents required by subsection (c) or (d). The files maintained shall be
- 35 available for inspection by members of the Senate during regular business hours unless the
- information is otherwise protected by state or federal law.
- 37 (f) In addition to the requirements of this rule, all procurements for legal services shall be
- approved by the Senate Counsel.
- 39 (g) If, in the determination of the Chief Financial Officer, an emergency procurement of greater
- 40 than \$10,000 is necessary, the Chief Financial Officer may procure the goods or services
- 41 immediately and create and maintain a file explaining the nature of the emergency and the goods
- or services that were procured as a result. The Chief Financial Officer shall document the goods
- or services that were procured, the process used to procure the goods or services, the vendors that
- 44 were contacted and any other information relevant to the procurement, and make that
- information available to members of the Senate during regular business hours, unless the
- information is otherwise protected by state or federal law. [2013.];
