An Act establishing Building Trades Opioids Awareness Week.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 15IIIIII the  
2 following section:-

3           Section 15JJJJJ. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart the last  
4 full week in April as Building Trades Opioids Awareness Week to promote awareness of the  
5 dangers of opioids and substance misuse among workers in the building trades industry and  
6 facilitate discussions and events to combat the opioid epidemic and promote mental health in the  
7 commonwealth's building trades industry.
