1 *Ordered*, That, the Senate hereby calls for a joint session of the two Houses, conformable
2 to the provisions of Article XLVIII (as amended by Article LXXXI) of the Amendments to the
3 Constitution, to consider the following proposal:

4 Proposal for a legislative amendment to the Constitution requiring a supermajority vote for the
5 utilization of rainy day funds (see Senate, No. 2210), with reference to which the committee on
6 Revenue has reported, in accordance with Joint Rule 23, that the amendment ought NOT to pass,
7 the time within which the said committee was required to report having expired..
