An Act prohibiting for-profit correctional facilities.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 126 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting, after
- 2 section 40, the following section:-
- 3 Section 41. (a) Except as otherwise provided in subsections (b) or (c) or in federal law,
- 4 the private operation or management of a correctional facility, jail or other facility for the
- 5 purpose of incarcerating inmates shall be prohibited.
- 6 (b) Nothing in this section shall limit in any way the authority of the commissioner,
- 7 sheriff or any municipality, to limit the responsibility of the department of corrections or
- 8 community supervision to supervise inmates or persons released to community supervision while
- 9 away from an institution.
- 10 (c) Nothing in this section shall preclude a sheriff, the commissioner of correction or any
- other municipal official in the unclassified service, as determined by state law or by the state or

- municipal government, from maintaining the custody and supervision of persons detained or
- 13 confined in a local correctional facility.
