**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act supporting job growth in the commonwealth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 63 of the Acts of 2007 is hereby amended by striking out section
2 15.

3 SECTION 2. Chapter 158 of the Acts of 2005 is hereby amended by striking out section
4 9 and inserting in place thereof the following: -

5 “This act shall be effective for tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2006.”
