In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)

An Act to enhance employment opportunities.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 148B of chapter 149 of the Massachusetts General Laws, as so
2 appearing, is hereby amended by striking out paragraph (a) and inserting in place thereof, the
3 following new paragraph:-

4 (a)For the purpose of this chapter and chapter 151, the Commonwealth shall adopt rules
5 and regulation to conform to section 3121 of the Internal Revenue Code and section 530 (d) of
6 the Revenue Act of 1978, as described in IRS Publication 15-A, as amended and in effect on
7 January 1, 2014.
