An Act relative to eligibility for unemployment benefits for furloughed federal employees.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1.   Section 24 of chapter 151A, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by doing the following:-

3           1) adding the figure "(1)" in line 45 after the words "is due to";

4           2) inserting the words "part 1 of" before the words "this paragraph" in line 50; and

5           3) by adding the words "; or (2) being placed on furlough as a federal employee or as an  
6 employee of the Commonwealth" after the word "year" in line 51.
