In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)

An Act relative to political contributions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1: Subsection (a) of section 7A of chapter 55 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by chapter 156 of the acts of 2016, is hereby further amended by striking out
3 paragraph (3) and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:-

4 (3) An individual may in addition make campaign contributions to any political
5 committee not specified in paragraph (1), (2), (4) or (5); provided, however, that the aggregate of
6 such campaign contributions to any one such political committee shall not exceed in any one
7 calendar year the sum of \$500.

8 SECTION 2: Said subsection (a) of said section 7A of said chapter 55, as so amended, is
9 hereby further amended by adding the following paragraph:-

10 (5) An individual may in addition make campaign contributions to any independent
11 expenditure PAC as defined in section 18A; provided, however, that the aggregate of campaign
12 contributions to any one such independent expenditure PAC shall not exceed in any one calendar
13 year the sum of \$5,000.
