An Act relative to hunting near a dwelling.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 58 of chapter 131 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 6, after the word "thereof" the following
3 words:-

4 , provided that a person may hunt with a bow and arrow from an elevated tree stand not
5 less than 250 feet from any dwelling in use except as authorized by the owner or occupant
6 thereof
