**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court  
(2021-2022)**

An Act relative to internet speed during the COVID-19 outbreak.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 (a) As used in this section, the following words shall, unless the context clearly requires  
2 otherwise, have the following meanings:-

3 “Internet service provider”, a person who provides internet access to customers in the  
4 commonwealth.

5 “State of emergency”, the state of emergency related to the outbreak COVID-19 in  
6 Massachusetts, declared by the governor pursuant to executive order 591 or any subsequent  
7 related order.

8 (b) Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, all Internet service  
9 providers shall provide all residential customers in the commonwealth with the highest  
10 bandwidth possible during the state of emergency in the manner that best ensures reliable  
11 internet access so all residential customers may telework and connect during the state of  
12 emergency.

- 13           (c) An Internet service provider shall not be required to adopt, create or implement new  
14 technology or build or implement new infrastructure to comply with subsection (b).
