Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition, is
- 2 hereby amended by adding at the end of subsection (4) of section 51G the following:-
- To preserve access to essential services, hospitals may not close any beds, units or
- 4 facilities for the duration of any declared state of emergency pertaining to health care.
